

## Intervention 2021 - 2022

For the first half term, all teachers will be directed to deliver at least one intervention session per week additional to one directed time CPD or departmental meeting.

### **Year 11:**

- Extended school day (P5) till 4:00 p.m Monday, Wednesday and Thursday
- Commence 2<sup>nd</sup> week (13<sup>th</sup> Sept) to ensure LLs & teachers establish where students are with learning and devise effective intervention plan to address issues
- All students – compulsory attendance communicated to parents (letter) and students.
- Refreshments provided

Half termly priorities -

- Autumn term – Tub 2 and Tub 3 - GCSE only
- Spring term 1 – Tub 1 and Tub 2
- Spring term 2 – Based on students' needs to max progress
